




#### What is the Argument?

 There are two different ways this problem can can be addressed:

1. How do we address the deconvert herself?

2. How do we address those who are convinced by the deconvert?







#### Why do People Leave the Church?

People leave the Church for a variety of reasons. Let's take their position at face value:

#### 1. Reason

- a. Intellectual Challenges
- 2. Justice and Politics
  - a. Racial
  - b. LGBTQ+
- 3. Personal Experiences

A good friend of mine was a real sold-out Christian, but eventually found out that all of that was fake and she left the church. Why should I believe your testimony over hers?






#### What does the Bible Say?

Hebrews 5:4-6,

For it is impossible, in the case of those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, and have shared in the Holy Spirit, 5 and have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the age to come, 6 and then have fallen away, to restore them again to repentance, since they are crucifying once again the Son of God to their own harm and holding him up to contempt.





#### **Theological Positions**

- 1. Calvinism (Perseverance of the saints)
  - a. The deconvert was never elect
  - b. The deconvert will return in the end

#### 2. Arminianism

- Salvation (and perseverance) is conditioned upon remaining in Christ.
- b. Apostasy requires willful rejection of Christ







### Disenculturation: An Alternative to Deconversion

Many of the problems people have with "Christianity" are actually problems with the white, affluent, american, 21st century evangelical subculture.

### Why don't we retranslate the Gospel out of this subculture?

Bible translators use disenculturation to translate the Bible without carrying too much of a foreign culture the readers will not understand.





#### Takeaways...?

- Take the stories of deconverts at face value
  - o Don't immediately minimize it
- Deconversion stories are stories, not histories
  - We are not reliable narrators
- Don't just accept someone's deconversion experience as evidence for yourself!
- A rigid certainty, especially unfounded, is brittle
