### **MKE Lit Supply: Podcast!**

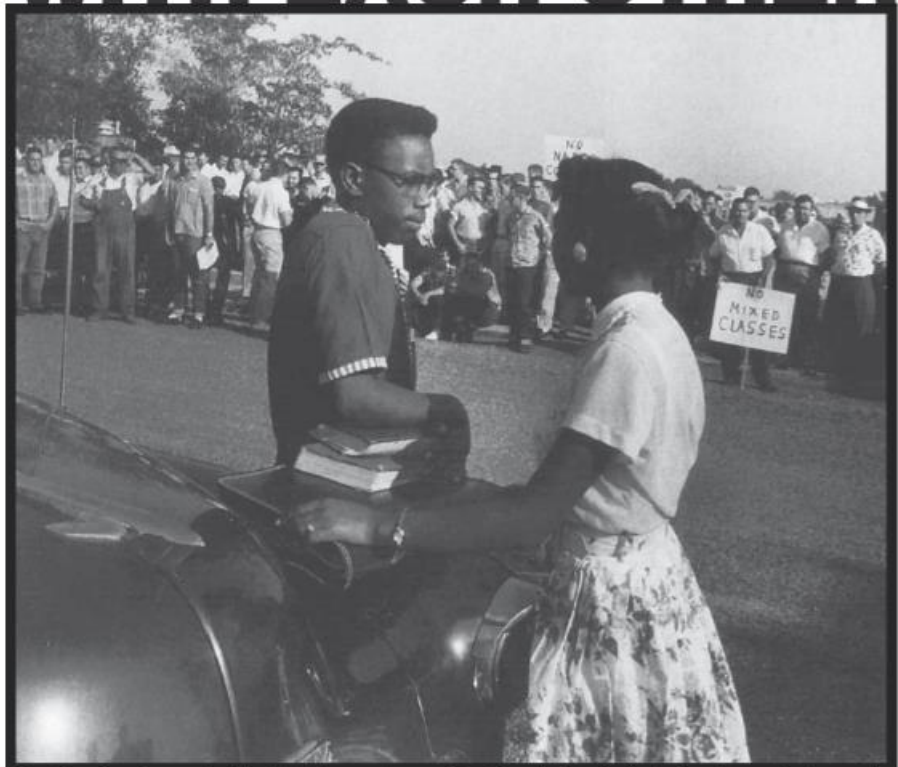
